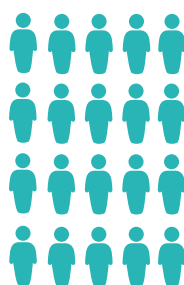
Cumbria has one of the largest industries in the UK for sheep and cattle stock.

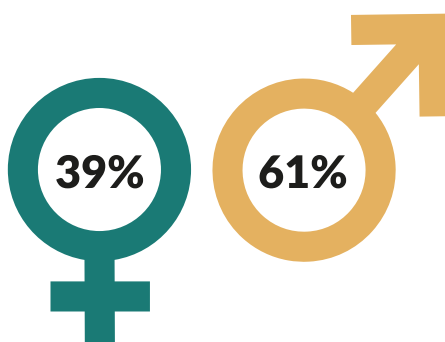

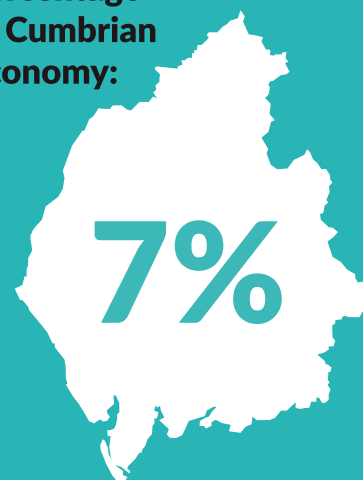

Workforce Characteristics:



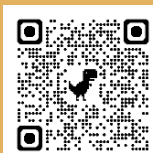
Percentage of Cumbrian Economy:
